Our pupils in the School Council have arranged to hold a **Toy Sale** in school on **Thursday 30th November.** If you wish to donate to this, please send in any preloved toys or books to school before Tuesday 28th. All pupils will have the opportunity during the day to purchase from the stalls. Toys £1, books 50p. Please send in correct change. All proceeds will go to our chosen charity of the year, Cancer Fund for Children.

We are participating in the **Christmas Tree Festival** organised by St Johns Parish Church, Caledon. The festival runs from **Thursday 30th November to Sunday 3rd December**. Please see attached leaflet with details.

P6/7 class have been invited to attend a **Carol Service in St Marks Armagh on Friday 1**st **December**. This will be during school hours. School will cover the cost of the bus.
